#### Gaelic Football SouthLake Rules

Equipment : soccerball

: vests

: soccer goals.

: whistle

Aim: to get the soccer ball through or over the top of the soccer goals:

- through the goals = 6 points
- over the top of the goals = 3 points

Start of the game:

- Two teams face each other as the start of a soccer game
- A goalie is appointed (They can not be touched once they have the ball in their hands)
- The ball is given to one side and they may begin any way they like
- The ball can be kicked soccer style You may travel twenty metres and must pass
- The ball can be kicked football (aussie) style
- The ball can be carried, when you run you must bounce every five steps, maximum three bounces
- The ball can be thrown
- The ball can be tapped
- The ball can be marked, five metres for a throw or kick. Once marked the player has a five step safety perimeter. Should a player from the other team enter their space a ten metre down field free is given.

Once the game has started the aim is to get the ball into the goals. When you are in possession you can be tagged. The other team is awarded the ball. A tag must be fair and on the shoulders, (without a push).

I have played this game from year 4s to 7s and they love it.
